

HP + AMD Inspired Programme Tiering Information T&C's

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

Any partner registered in the United Kingdom who is currently a participating partner in the HP + AMD Inspired Programme

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

To be eligible to participate in this Participants must:

- be Partners with an open TD SYNnex UK Limited ("TD SYNnex") customer account, or;
- not be public sector entities (as further explained in Terms and Conditions below).
- accept and comply with the Program Terms and Conditions [below].

TIERING CRITERIA:

Bronze Tier: Partners will qualify for Bronze tier status upon successful registration and acceptance into the HP + AMD Inspired Programme. There is no minimum AMD unit purchase requirement to enter or remain at Bronze tier; however, partners must continue to meet the Programme eligibility criteria and comply with these Terms and Conditions to maintain their participation.

Silver Tier: Partners will qualify for Silver tier status by achieving a minimum of 25 AMD units purchased per month. To maintain Silver tier status, partners must purchase a minimum of 100 AMD units over each rolling six-month review period. Partners who do not meet the required maintenance threshold may be moved to the appropriate tier based on their AMD unit performance at the time of review.

Gold Tier: Partners will qualify for Gold tier status by achieving a minimum of 100 AMD units purchased per month. To maintain Gold tier status, partners must purchase a minimum of 250 AMD units over each rolling six-month review period. Partners who do not meet the required maintenance threshold may be moved to the appropriate tier based on their AMD unit performance at the time of review.

POINTS CRITERIA:

Within the Programme, qualifying AMD unit sales will act as points and will be used to determine each partner's tier status and progression. Each eligible HP + AMD unit sold contributes towards the partner's overall unit total for the relevant review period. Points will start being accrued from the week the partner gains access to the programme. Points will become available to accrue to those who have entered from the launch on 13th July 2026 – 13th July 2027.
